

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PRACTICE OR EVENTS

ANYONE riding or spectating at our RJ Motosport does so at their own risk. All children are the responsibility of the parents or their guardians. Make sure you know where your children are at all times.

ALL guests must sign a waiver at the start of each season before your first visit to RJ Motosport

Any participant under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian present at all times during practice.

If a parent or guardian is unable to attend, all required paperwork must be completed and submitted **in advance** before another adult may bring the minor to the track.

Please call ahead 7057223800 or visit our website to obtain and complete the required forms:

- Minor Application
- Parental Consent Form
- Practice Application

In addition, MINORS must provide a **note for each visit** stating who the responsible guardian will be for that day.

If a guest begins to ride without checking in/paying at our Pro Shop the result will be a minimum \$200 fine. And may be asked to leave the premises even the group they are with.

ALL guests must stop and check-in at our Service Office upon arrival. Daily fees must be paid before exiting the Service Office.

ALL guests must be familiar with facility rules and regulations before taking part in any activity at RJ Motosport.

We have a speed limit of 20 km/h in all driveways, pit area and parking fields. This rule is for all vehicles, dirt bikes, ATV's, and Side by Sides. Our pit area can be very busy with pedestrians and children.

Bike's and ATV travelling to tracks and Shop 1st gear ONLY

There is absolutely no riding in the grass fields or and other grass areas. This includes all bikes and ATV's, keep your machines in the dirt. Failing to follow this rule will result in a \$200 fine.

Proper riding gear is required. It is **mandatory** to wear a proper full face off-road helmet, MX Boots, Helmet, Chest Protector, Goggles and Gloves.

Additional recommended safety gear are as follows: neck brace, mouth guard, knee pads and elbow pads, MX Pants and MX Jersey.

Rental equipment is available for a fee:

- **MX Boots:** \$30
- **Chest Protector:** \$15

A **valid driver's license is required as a deposit** and will be held until the equipment is returned in **good condition**.

Helmets are mandatory on all machines at all times. This includes riding in the pits to the courses and coming down to the service shop.

Make sure that you are riding the correct track for your model size and skill level. If you are unsure which course you can ride staff will assist you if we felt you are in the wrong practice or track

Wednesday – Open Practice

9:30 AM – 6:00 PM

Saturday – Practice Run in Motos

Classes are divided into groups to keep the track safe and enjoyable for all riders:

- **Pro / Intermediate**
- **Jumpers**
- **Non-Jumpers / Beginner Riders**

Our **staff will assist you** if you are unsure which practice moto group you should ride in.

Schedule

- **9:30 – 10:00 AM:** Open Ride / Warm-Up
- **10:00 AM:** Practice moto's begin

Moto rotation (approximately **15–20 minutes each**):

1. **Pro / Intermediate**
2. **Jumpers**
3. **Non-Jumpers / Beginners**

Each group will rotate throughout the day.

*An additional time slot may be added for an **ATV class** depending on rider turnout.*

Mini Track is for 50cc riders and beginners ONLY! Ask our staff to assist if required

Do not at any point cut the track or trails when riding. Follow the full course and do not alter it.

Double riding is not allowed

Riders are under the obligation to know their surroundings. Check tracks do site laps

All dogs /animals must be on a leash

NO dumping any oil on the ground. The result of draining your oil, GAS OR ANTIFREEZE OR HAZARDOUS WASTE ON THE GROUND and no leaving of old tires. This is illegal and very harmful to the environment. There is a \$2,000 fine. We have oil disposal at our Service Area that is free.

Please clean up after yourself prior to leaving, please use our trash cans.

No dumping of Grey Water or Sewage allowed

Please use caution smoking as careless disposal may cause a fire

Absolutely NO open air burning permitted no wood fires or charcoal.

You may only use portable, authorized gas or propane stoves with a shut-off valve and not left unattended

Please check with staff if required

We ask that all guests use common sense and express courtesy towards their fellow guests and staff

NO ALCOHOL on the premises. This rule applies to all spectators and participants alike.
